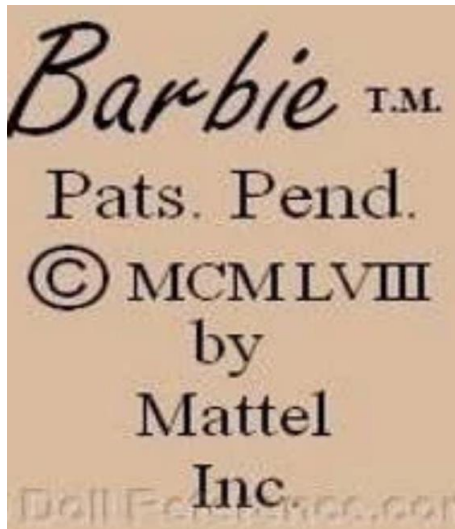

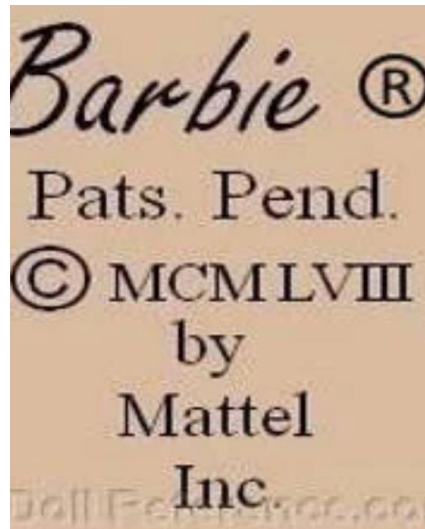

Please consider your doll based on the criteria below. If any of these details do not illustrate your doll, you may not have a vintage Barbie. If you still have questions or are unsure, register and bring your Barbie in for evaluation.

1. Dolls should be manufactured between 1959-1972. The very first dolls had wire in their legs and holes in their feet to hold the shoes on.
2. Dolls stamped 1966 must also be made in Japan or Taiwan only – there will be a Japan or Taiwan stamp on the back of your doll.
3. Bring any clothing, accessories or anything Barbie related from that era that you would like appraised.
